Jesse Norman is a member of the House of Commons and a minister in the UK Government.

His 2013 book, *Edmund Burke: philosopher, politician, prophet*, was longlisted for the Samuel Johnson Prize and his forthcoming book, *Adam Smith: what he thought, and why it matters*, will be published later this year.
